I trust everyone enjoyed a relaxing break over Christmas/New Year period and now it is back to business matters.

Since our last meeting in December, the following matters are noted.

- Nothing further has proceeded with our website upgrade as we have not received the Grant of \$2,000
 from Cardinia Shire Council for this project. We accepted the grant approx. 18.12.2015 and have
 contacted Cardinia Shire on a few occasions, but still no funds have been received. We will continue to
 press Council to pay the grant so we can undertake the project Barry Hyde is our IT person and is ready to
 proceed.
- We need to have a general discussion on future production of the Beaconsfield Banner. I telephoned Margaret Boon and discussed her availability and future direction bearing in mind the quantities of Banners to be produced will reduce when the Banner is placed on the BPA website.
- 3. The Association will again conduct an Anzac Memorial Service. Planning has been commenced by Margaret Boon and we need input tonight particularly on a keynote speaker
- 4. All Statutory financial accounting responsibilities are up-to-date including lodgement of the Annual Return with Office of Fair Trading and BAS Returns.
- 5. As noted in Correspondence, we have lodged Final Reports with Department of Premier and Cabinet for Grants received for Restoring Community War Memorials and Anzac Centenary Community Grants Program and have received acknowledgement from Cathy Nash Project Officer.

All of these matters will be discussed further under Reports and General Business.

We need to discuss ways and means of encouraging more people to attend BPA Inc. meetings and hopefully contribute and become members and assume responsibilities.

In addition we need to plan our future meetings and arrange for guest speakers on topical local issues to attract more people to attend.
