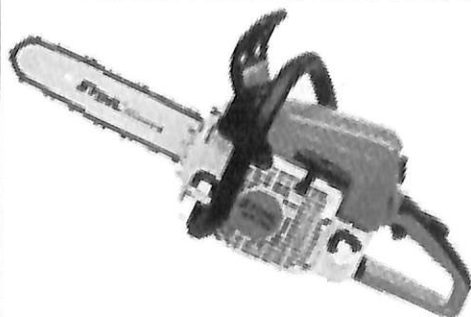

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Welcome everyone to the New Year, which promises to be another eventful and challenging year.

The Cardinia Shire Council Meeting for December was held for the first time at Holm Park Reserve Pavilion and attracted many residents and visitors. At that meeting the Beaconsfield Structure Plan was formally adopted which is the blueprint for future development and amenities for the next 10-15 years. Councillors including our Ward Councillors spoke with passion on the plan developed over a two year period with extensive community consultation. The petition that BPA lodged against some aspects including residents' concerns of up to six storey buildings in our area was successful in having the height limit reduced to 4 storeys in the final plan. Thanks to all who contributed and special thanks to Belinda Powell and other Cardinia Shire staff for completing this document.

The Open Air Burning Policy also had extensive community consultation within Cardinia Shire and was adopted at the December Council Meeting. Properties in zone 1 of less than 1 hectare of land will not be permitted to burn in the open. Properties in zone 2 are not permitted to burn on Sundays and the Fire Restriction period. The policy will be reviewed in 12 months time.

The Toucan Display Boards have been collected and

will be used by the BPA for special displays and events in the town including the Anzac Day Memorial Service. Thanks to Council for contributing funds.

Carols by the Creek held on 22 December was a great event enjoyed by many residents of Beaconsfield and surrounding areas. Our Association partners with Beaconsfield Baptist Church in this event and many thanks to all involved for a very enjoyable evening.

It was pleasing to see the new footpaths made alongside Beaconsfield Emerald Road near Fieldstone Boulevard and also across the road a path to the tennis court and Akoonah Park.

At the November meeting, the members adopted new rules of our Incorporated Body. Our new rules are based on model rules provided by Justice Connect (formerly Pilchconnect) and also included specific Rules from our previous constitution document. Recently advice was received from the Department of Justice that they had approved these new rules.

Finally it was good to see Richmond Football Club training at Holm Park Reserve on the Australia Day Public Holiday. The significant crowd attracted, increases the awareness of our town and facilities and was a great promotion for Beaconsfield and Cardinia Shire.

The Beaconsfield Structure Plan

The Beaconsfield Structure Plan was adopted in December. Thanks to those who provided input as a result of the extensive community consultation. The Structure Plan will guide the development of Beaconsfield over the next 10-15 years.

Holm Park Reserve

Construction of the Netball pavilion is well underway. The 152sqm facility will consist of a social room, umpires change room, kitchen, store, public amenities, external veranda, paving, disabled car park and access paths. Works on the sealing of the main entrance road to the main pavilion has also been completed. Improved lighting to the entrance and main car park will follow soon. The community room within the main pavilion is a 50m2 space that is able to be used by the whole community for events, meetings, presentations and training. The room has the following features available at no extra cost-

- Electronic whiteboard
- 50 inch TV (with USB connectivity)
- Kitchenette facilities including fridge with freezer, microwave, sink and urn.

New Footpaths

A new footpath along Beaconsfield Emerald Road between the access driveway to the shops and Fieldstone Boulevard has been installed. These works included improved access to Perc Allison Reserve. Further path improvements along the Cardinia Creek will also be completed soon. This is part of Council's ongoing commitment to improve pedestrian access in Beaconsfield. The long awaited footpath from the traffic lights at Princes Hwy/Old Princes Highway to O'Neil Road is imminent. Council was advised by the developer of the Pink Hill subdivision that the footpath and associated works should be commenced in the first quarter of this year.

BEACONSFIELD FIRE BRIGADE NEWS

It was a very busy Christmas period with a house fire in Berwick on Christmas eve and an unusual number of calls on Christmas day with the first call to a young boy who sadly fell from his bike resulting in the brake handle being impaled into his leg. It took some time with the support of Nar Nar Goon rescue and paramedics to free him and transport to hospital.

The next call at 2.20 was a motor vehicle accident in Beaconsfield and the following call that evening was a transformer fire that lead to the brigade

members not returning till 2.am. This is not a typical Christmas day but is a window into the dedication of brigade members in protecting the community they willingly serve.

As the fire season is still very much upon us with the Captain Paul Hayes already being deployed to a very difficult fire in the Grampians and firefighter Andrew Wenzel to East Gippsland we ask that every citizen plays their part to minimise the threat of fire taking particular care with machinery in dry grass areas.



It is important to remind everyone that a fire plan is imperative and that you take time to be aware of the fire risk this summer especially in bush and heavy grassland areas.

listen to and monitor any emergency updates via radio, internet or other social media in the event of a fire or code red day.

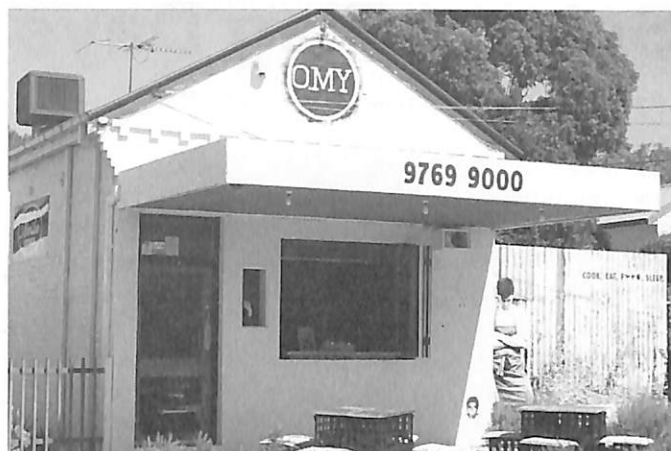
The brothers are joined in the restaurant by an experienced and youthful team that all have a passion for the restaurant to succeed.

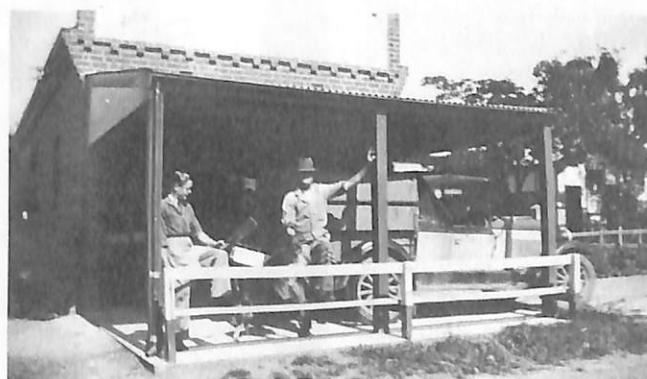

School Flag Days

The recent Australia Day flag ceremonies have reminded me of the flag raising ceremonies we had at primary school when I was at school. Every Monday without fail we would assemble in the quadrangle to raise the Australian Flag, sing the National Anthem - God Save the Queen - and say the pledge with our hands over our hearts. We repeated faithfully:

**"I love God and my country;
I honour the flag;
I will serve the Queen,
and cheerfully obey my parents, teachers and the laws."**

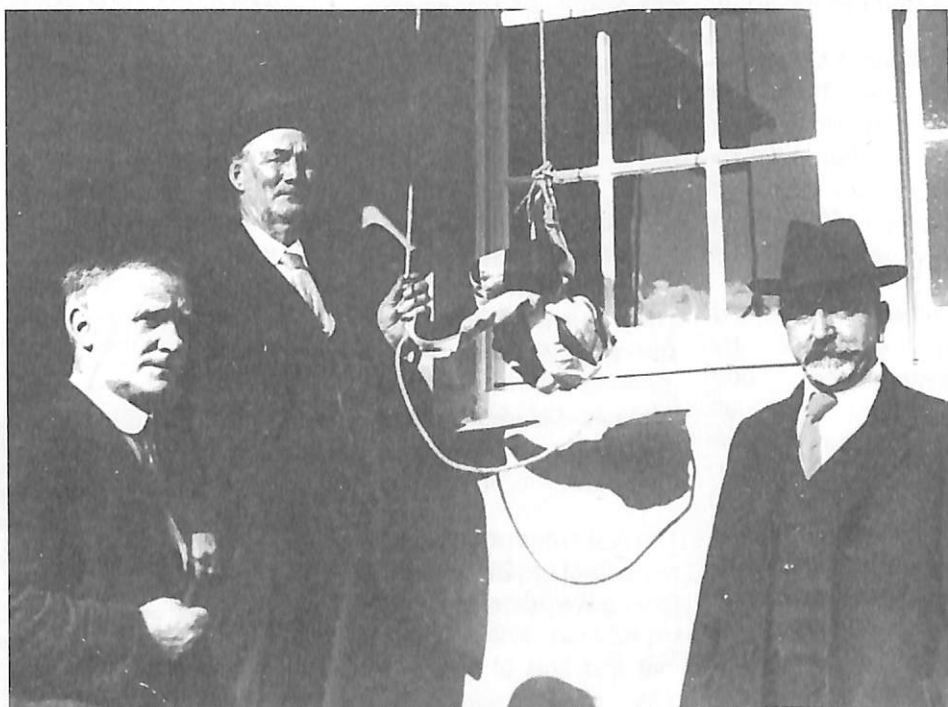
BEACONSFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL is over 100 years old and the first classes were held in 1890. Audrey Dodson has compiled a wonderful little booklet, Beaconsfield P.S. 1890-1990; The School And Its District. This can be borrowed from your local public library.

Page 35 has details of the flag raising ceremony. "In Victoria in 1920 the Education Department had ruled that it was part of each teacher's duty to conduct the flag ceremony every Monday morning. The Schoolpapers were full of patriotic fervour in

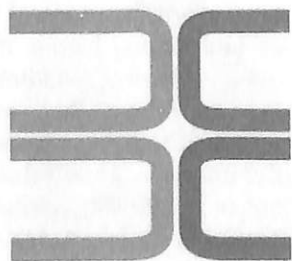
April for Anzac Day, in May for Empire Day and the celebration of peace in November. Beaconsfield faithfully observed Monday ceremonies and patriotic days. The General Course of Study for Elementary Schools of 1933 suggests that "The fitting celebration of special days such as Anzac Day, Armistice Day, Arbor Day, Empire Day etc. is another valuable

link with the community".

The Civics course for grades seven and eight suggested that participation in these activities was the best way of attaining civic pride. Before this in 1922 on Anzac Day seventy five people had gathered at the school to hear eight people address the assembly. Pupils entertained with songs and recitations.

The flag was saluted and the National Anthem sung. Empire Day was chosen that year as School Picnic Day.

In 1928 the children of Beaconsfield received a Union Jack from Beaconsfield School, England. They in return sent an Australian Flag to England which they had hand stitched (every child in the school did a stitch). A new pole had to be erected for the flag, which was officially presented to the school on Saturday November 10th, 1928. (Pictured above)

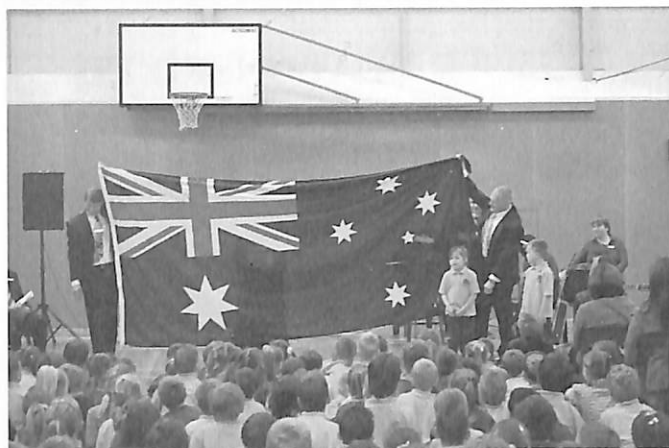
... Arbor Day too is remembered by ex-students. Official approval for recognition of Arbor Day dates from June 1901, and in May 1904 the Minister of Education hoped that all schools would observe it."

The original old brick school house served faithfully for over 100 years and finally was demolished along with other old buildings in 1997.

New school buildings, stage one of the master plan was completed in 1998 and officially opened by Robert Maclellan,

Minister for Planning and Local Government. The bluestone sills, bricks and door from the original building have been included in the new building. In 2007 the stage two development was opened by Tammy Lobato, the Member for Gembrook.

A flag raising ceremony was also held that day with a newly erected flag pole - a gift from the Australian Government and the Member for La Trobe Jason Wood also presented the school with an enormous Australian



flag. (Pictured above)

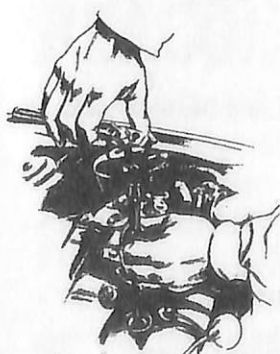

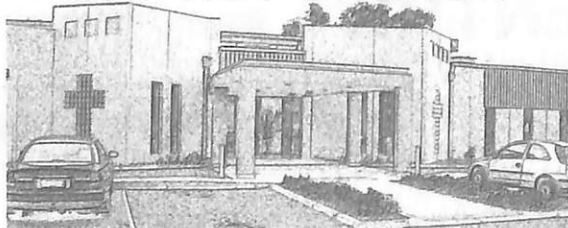

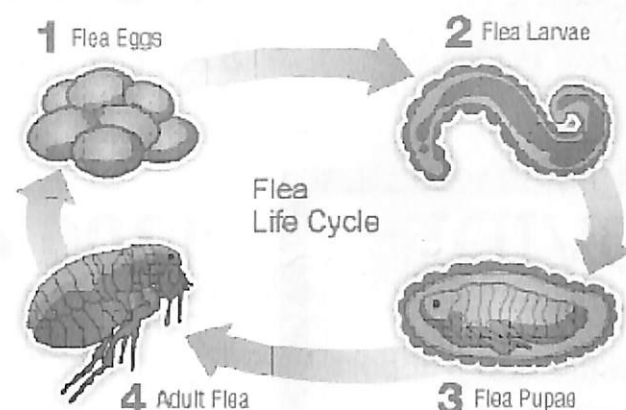

Understanding Fleas

There are over 2000 species of flea in the world. Thankfully, only the cat flea and the dog flea are an issue to dogs and cats. Adult fleas have specially adapted mouth parts for piercing the skin and sucking blood. More than just annoying and irritating to your pets, they can also cause significant skin disease. Flea blood feeding is also associated with the transmission of several infectious diseases to both pets and people in Australia.

Flea Allergy Dermatitis is one of the most common problems we see with flea infestations. It's an itchy skin disease animals develop from an allergic reaction to the saliva of fleas. An affected pet will be very itchy, often scratching, biting, licking and chewing. Their skin is usually reddened and there may be lesions and hair loss.



To understand fleas and how to prevent them we first need to understand the flea life cycle.

One female flea can lay up to 20-50 eggs per day and up to 2000 eggs in her lifetime (usually 2-3 months).

Once the adult flea has fed on our pets it will then lay its eggs within 36 hours. These eggs are not sticky and fall from our pets and into the environment. This means, our carpet, sofas, beds, in-between floor boards and anywhere else our pets may go.

It can take up to 10 days, but these eggs then hatch and become flea larvae. And for the next 5-11 days this worm like creature buries itself deeper into those dark hiding places before wrapping itself in a cocoon and becoming the next part of the cycle, the flea pupae.

The flea pupae are a sticky impenetrable cocoon that become covered in debris and cannot be killed by insecticides. Usually the pupae takes 5-14 days to fully develop into a flea but can lay dormant for up to 6 months. It's at this point all it takes is for the

warmth and vibrations of a moving animal to cause the newly developed flea to emerge from the cocoon and jump onto its unsuspecting host starting the cycle all over again.

So, how do we stop this invasion of blood sucking insects? Prevention is the key. Once an infestation has started around the home it can potentially take months to get it under control.

Once monthly spot on treatments and once monthly tablet/chews are the latest in flea prevention and work extremely well. Not only do they kill adult fleas but most of them break the flea life cycle and prevent further infestation. Flea collars, sprays and powders are available, however these products are old fashioned and might only last a few days if at all. As there are many different products on the market it would be best to speak to us to decide on which product is best for your pets.

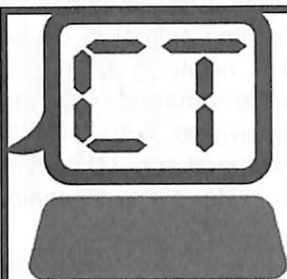

SNIPPETS FROM THE ACCOUNTANTS DESK

UNCLAIMED SUPERANNUATION

According to the latest statistics the amount of lost and unclaimed superannuation is approx. \$17 billion held in 3.4 million separate accounts.

To be a lost member of a super fund certain conditions apply:

-fund never had an address or mail has been returned from the last known address and no fund activity in the past 12 months.

-member is inactive including no contributions or rollovers in the past 5 years.

Unclaimed superannuation amounts held by Super Funds are where:

-a member has reached eligibility age (normally 65) and the fund is unable to contact the member after making reasonable efforts.

-if a member has died and the super fund determines a benefit is immediately payable however is unable to be satisfied

of the person to receive the benefit. SuperFunds are required to report to the ATO amounts of lost and unclaimed Super held by them.

The ATO then keeps a register of these members' accounts. The Super Funds usually retain the monies, however, small amounts of less than \$2,000 and inactive accounts are required to be transferred to the ATO.

On their website the ATO lists the lost and unclaimed Super amounts on SuperSeeker. Individuals can use this online tool to identify their lost and unclaimed super and reclaim benefits from the Superfund or ATO. A quick search can be undertaken by providing limited personal details by

registering using two items of information already held by the ATO.

If you think that some of your super is deemed lost or unclaimed you should search the SuperSeeker website and gain access.

In the future, ensure super is not treated as lost ensuring that your correct address is held by the Super Fund(s) particularly if you change employers and future contributions made to a different fund.

Discuss with your Accountant.





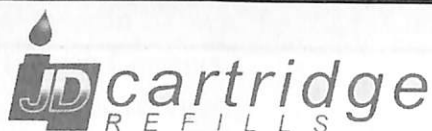

TALKING WEATHER

The start of the year has seen very little rain. We have only had 30mm for the year so far. There has also only been rain on 4 days as well.

In December we had 72mm of rain recorded in Beaconsfield. There was only 6 days of rain and the highest daily total was on the 9th when we had 25mm. This took our yearly total to 954mm.

This yearly total of 954mm of rain fell over 106 days. This was the lowest total since 2009 and it also fell on fewer days. However this is still 200mm above the yearly average for Beaconsfield.

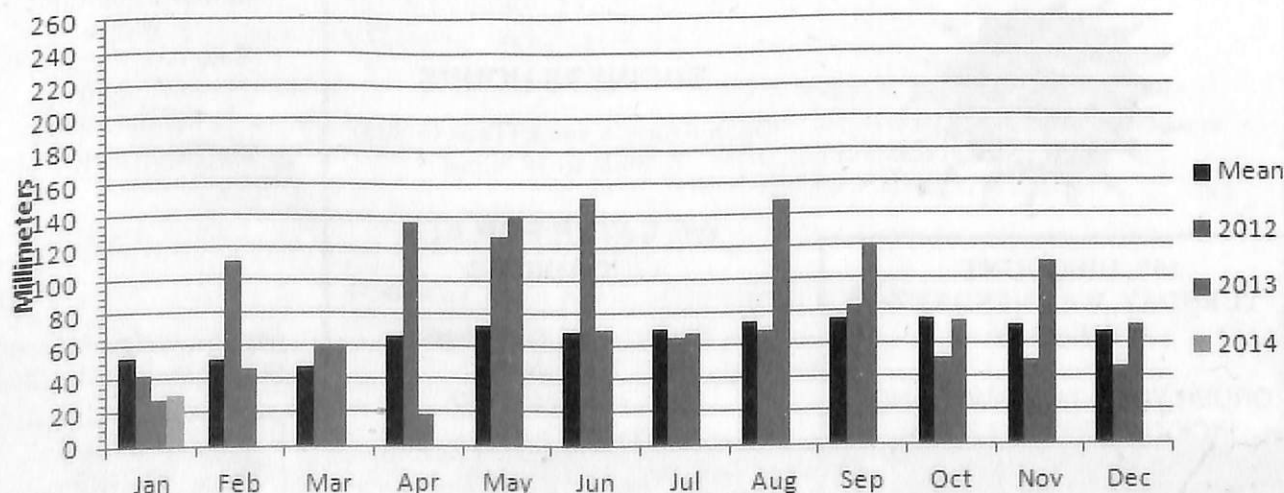
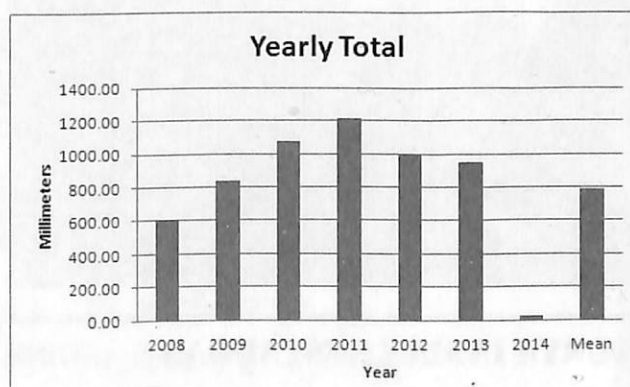
It is not rain that has been the topic of conversation so far this year. It has been the heat. We have endured some very long, hot days and while summer is coming to an end the hot days are continuing.

In January we had 11 days over 30c. This included 5 days over 40c with the highest temperature being 43.9c. This was recorded on both the 16th and 17th January.

The decrease in rainfall and the high temps have seen the Melbourne water storage levels drop. They are currently at 77.4% capacity. This is a 6% decrease since December.

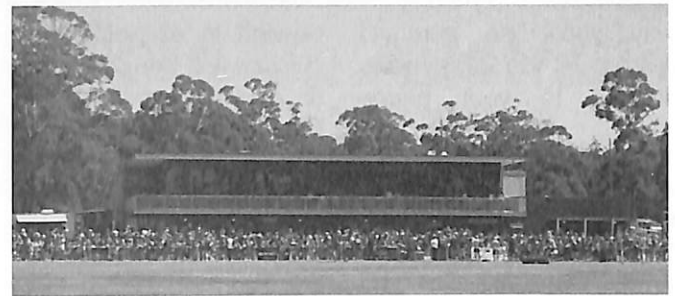

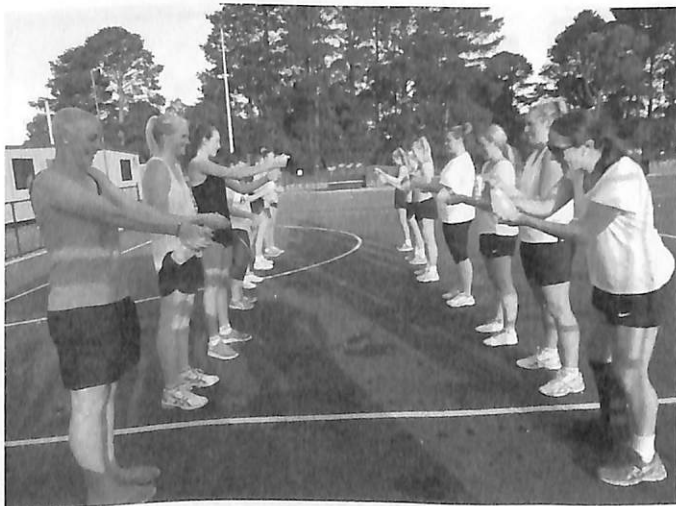

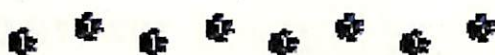
